

COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHT

Shawnee Disaster Recovery Center

South Central Industries had the honor of being selected as a Disaster Recovery Center for residents in the aftermath of the tornado that destroyed homes, businesses and lives in our community. Governor Stitt requested an expedited major disaster declaration from the federal government. Aerial damage assessments conducted by FEMA found more than 2,000 homes and apartments impacted, including at least 231 that sustained major damage or were destroyed. Of those 2,000 homes impacted, 50% were uninsured and an additional 25% were underinsured. FEMA opened a Disaster Recovery Center at South Central Industries, 130 N Louisa, Shawnee, shortly after the storm on the first of June to help with temporary housing expenses, basic home repairs, or other essential disasterrelated needs that were not covered by insurance. Our employees dedicated many hours to help clean up our campus, employee homes and our neighborhood in every way we could lend a hand and resources. Our facility and employees were thankful to be used by our community for important recovery efforts.



Adhering to its mission of providing employment and residential opportunities and services to individuals with IDD, South Central has developed mission aligned business models that provide above minimum-wage paying work opportunities and constructed affordable housing for lowincome and individuals with IDD.
